## PROCEDURE FOR SAFE CARE

MAKE CONTACT	
GATHER INFORMATION HERE AND NOW	<ul> <li>Verify all the elements of the work situation</li> <li>Verify the person's abilities</li> </ul>
ANALYZE	Is it safe?  YES → I can proceed as planned  NO → Should I consult someone?  → I adapt the situation
PREPARATION	<ul> <li>→ Environment</li> <li>→ Equipment</li> <li>→ Person         <ul> <li>Glasses</li> <li>Natural movements</li> <li>Start code</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
POSTURE	<ul> <li>Feet positioned to provide balance and facilitate movement</li> <li>No bending, twisting or arching of the back</li> <li>Elbows close to the body</li> <li>Head upright</li> </ul>
H HOLD	<ul> <li>→ Solid</li> <li>→ Reassuring for the person</li> <li>→ Stable</li> <li>→ Close to the caregiver</li> <li>→ Gentle</li> </ul>
M MOVEMENT	<ul> <li>Explain the movement: position at the start and at the end</li> <li>Mimic the action once, using exaggerated gestures</li> <li>Carry out the movement</li> </ul>
WRAP UP	<ul> <li>→ With the person (comfort, safety)</li> <li>→ Follow-up with the team, if necessary</li> </ul>
